For Immediate Release April 27, 2020 – Saint John, NB.

Economic Development Greater Saint John has an important role to play in leading regional economic response and recovery efforts during the COVID-19 crisis. During this critical time, the local economy of the Greater Saint John region is facing a period of great stress and uncertainty. Businesses are challenged to stay open, support their employees, and navigate the rapidly changing provincial and federal relief programs.
